THE ASSIGNMENT:

Write an academic argument making the case for your answer to your fellow scholars-intraining in this course.

You may draw upon Stark for establishing a framework for your discussion. In developing your evidence, you may want to consider the range of roles for women's participation shown or suggested in Matthew and to what extent Matthew appears to be addressing women as well as men, or equally with men.
