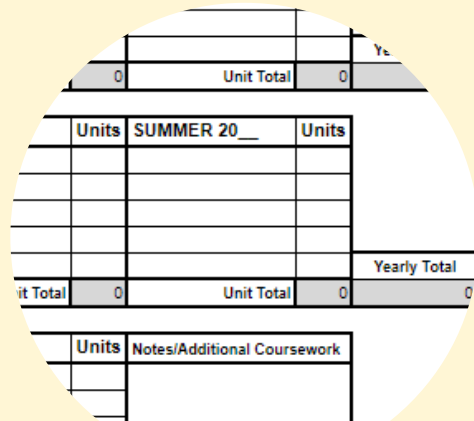


CREATING AN ACADEMIC PLAN

1 USE A QUARTER-BY-QUARTER TEMPLATE

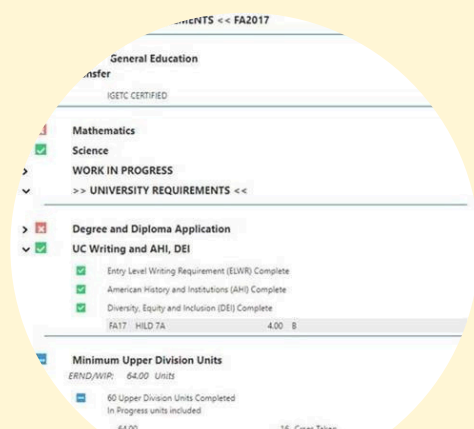

2 REFERENCE SAMPLE ACADEMIC PLANS

Check the general four-year plans and transfer plans made in collaboration between majors and the college. Use this as a guide and adjust your personal plan as needed.

3 CHECK YOUR DEGREE AUDIT

Use your Degree Audit to track your academic progress towards graduation. You can see what you have completed, have work-in-progress, and what is still required.

4 REVIEW THE GENERAL CATALOG & WEBSITES

- Check college website for GE's and department website for major requirements.

5 MEET WITH MAJOR ADVISOR

To confirm all major requirements are accounted for.

MEET WITH ERC ADVISOR

Meet with the college **after** the department to verify graduation plan.
