take an exploratory / introductory class for a major

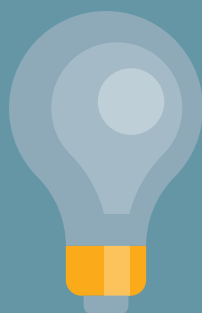
Work with an ERC Academic Counselor to see what course(s) you can take in your area(s) of interest and how they can fit in your academic plans.
