





Courses Acceptable From Community Colleges For Partial IGETC Using Assist.org



Hi! This video is presented by the ERC Peer Advisors and it will address how to search for community college courses using Assist.org and see if they are acceptable to complete Partial IGETC requirements at UC San Diego.




In this example, we will be looking up courses under San Diego Mesa College that are applicable for IGETC at UC schools. The first step is to go to <http://www.assist.org>.



On the “Welcome” page, click on the “Click here to select an institution” pull down menu and select the community college where you have taken courses or plan on attending. In our case, we’ll select San Diego Mesa College.

The next column tells you which quarter that course was approved for the IGETC area. The letter refers to the semester and the numbers referring to the year. F stands for Fall, W stands for Winter, and S stands for Spring.

In this example, the first row says, "F91". This means that BIOL 100 from San Diego Mesa College was approved in Fall 1991 for Area 5B for the IGETC agreement. So as long as you took BIOL 100 during Fall of 1991 or after, it is applicable to the Area 5B of IGETC.



The last column indicates if the course has been removed from being approved for the IGETC area. For example, the second course, BIOL 105, is not eligible for Area 5B of IGETC if it was taken after Fall 2000. If it was taken between Fall of 1991 and Fall of 2000 then it would still be applicable for Area 5B of IGETC.

Make sure to read every column carefully when planning your courses.



Let's go back to the page where you clicked on "IGETC for UC and CSU".

The other way to find courses that can count towards IGETC is by searching the IGETC Area you want to complete. Use the pull-down to select the area you're looking to complete. In this example, we'll look at Area 5.

The different here is that the top of the page will tell you what IGETC Area you're looking at and another header below that showing what specific section of that area the course could be applied to.

There is also another column that shows whether the course can be counted towards more than one IGETC area.
