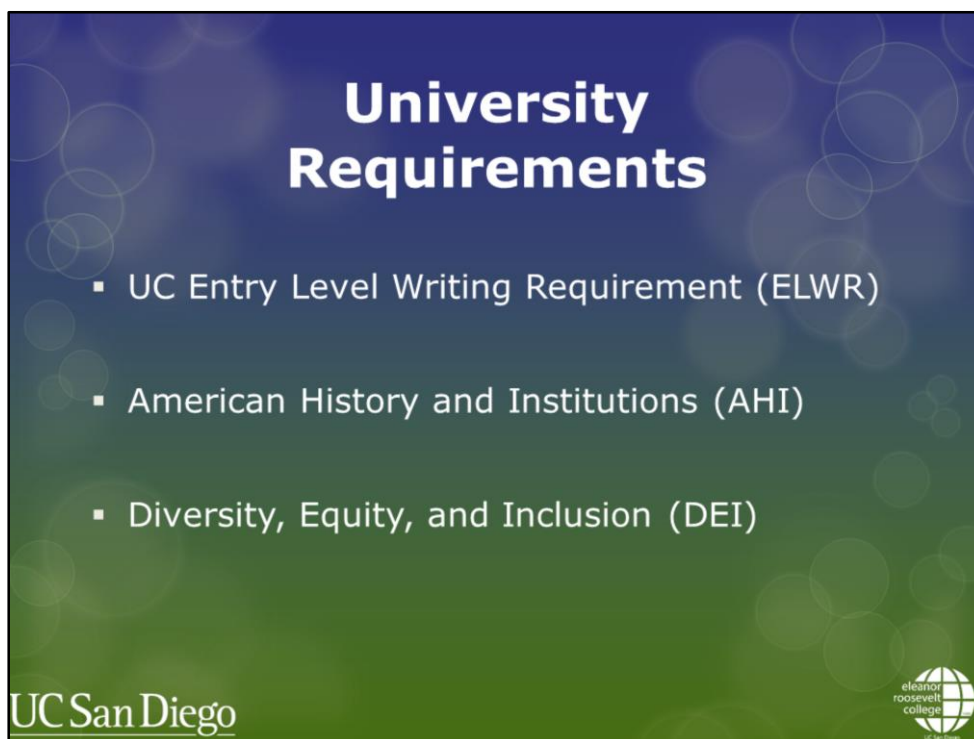




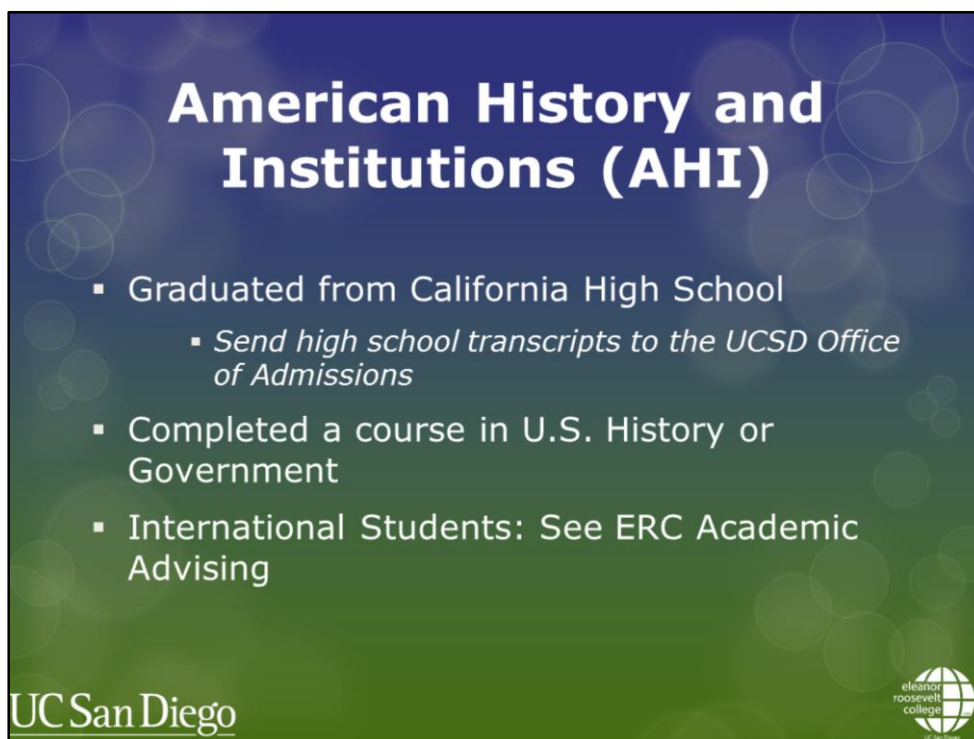
This Video will provide an overview of your University requirements.

These are requirements that all UC San Diego students, regardless of college or major, will need to complete in order to graduate.



All students must complete these three university requirements to graduate. For transfer students, the [UC Entry Level Writing Requirement](#), also known as ELWR, will already be met using your transfer courses.

Let's learn about your options for filling the remaining two requirements.

American History and Institutions (AHI)

- Graduated from California High School
 - *Send high school transcripts to the UCSD Office of Admissions*
- Completed a course in U.S. History or Government
- International Students: See ERC Academic Advising

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The next requirement is [American History and Institutions](#), also known as AHI. The University requires knowledge of American history and/or government.

If you graduated from a California high school, your AHI requirement is complete. If you attended high school outside of California, you can clear the requirement with comparable coursework. Please refer to an ERC Academic Counselor for course options.

If you are an International student, please consult with an ERC Academic Counselor in the Fall and we will explain how you will clear the requirement.

This course can overlap with major or GE requirements. Here are some examples of courses students have taken for DEI.



Degree Requirements For Graduation

- 180 total units
 - 60 units must be upper-division
- 2.00 Major and Overall GPA minimum

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In addition to these university requirements, you must also complete certain degree requirements to graduate.

You must complete at least 180 total units, 60 of which must be upper-division. Most majors require only 48 upper-division units so you may need additional upper-division electives to reach 60 units. Remember, upper-division courses are numbered 100 through 199 at UC San Diego.

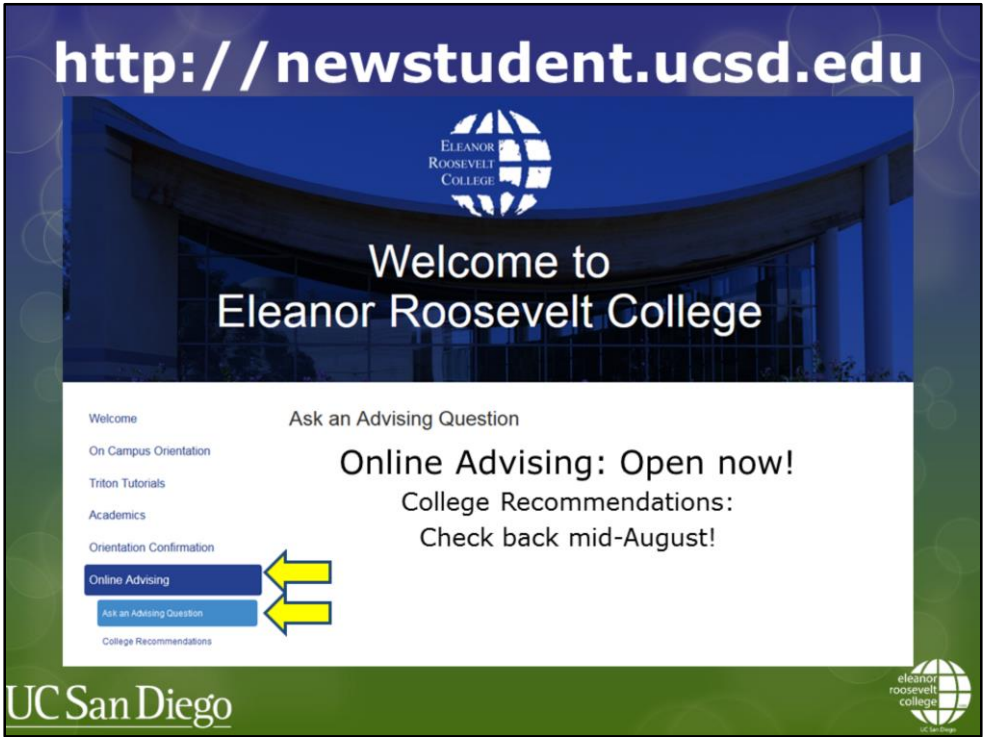
You must also achieve a minimum 2.00 major and overall GPA to graduate.

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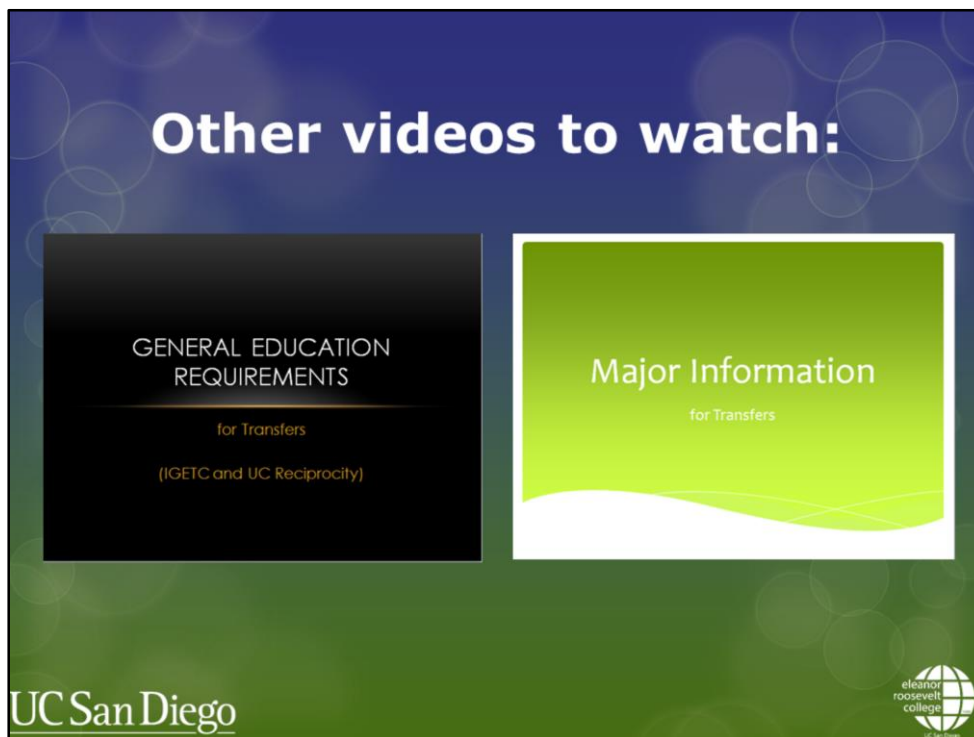
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Remember, these are just sample plans and your transfer courses and academic background information will help your advisors determine what courses you should be starting off with in Fall.
