- ✓ If you have a non-U.S. passport, please see the International Students and Programs Office by early November for Visa Regulations Advising to Mexico: <https://ispo.ucsd.edu/about/contact.html#Walk-In-Advising>. Please plan in advance!
- ✓ You must comply with all UC policies and procedures, even though away from campus, including UC non-discrimination/harassment policies. You will be provided with a copy of the Office for the Prevention of Harassment & Discrimination FAQ for Students.

- ✓ You must fully participated in the all-day program on January 19, 2019 and January 26, 2019. No exceptions.
