


Academic plans will help you stay on track towards graduating from UC San Diego. Here are essential steps on how to build your own personal plan:

2 REFERENCE SAMPLE ACADEMIC PLANS


Check the general four-year plans and transfer plans made in collaboration between majors and the college. Use this as a guide and adjust your personal plan as needed.



CHECK YOUR DEGREE AUDIT

Use your Degree Audit to track your academic progress towards graduation. You can see what you have completed, have work-in-progress, and what is still required.

- Check college website for GEs and department website for major requirements.



MEET WITH MAJOR ADVISOR

To confirm all major requirements are accounted for.

MEET WITH ERC ADVISOR

Meet with the college <u>after</u> the department to verify graduation plan.
