



## **ERC 92 Sophomore Honors Project** ***Application Information and Procedures***

The ERC Sophomore Honors Project intends to introduce you to the requirements of research while providing the opportunity to study in depth a topic of particular interest. The project must be carefully planned with the faculty advisor.

To qualify you must have at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average and completed MMW 11, 12, and 13. During your sophomore year, you will need to complete MMW 14 and 15.

A P/NP grade will be assigned by the faculty advisor for 2 units of credit at the end of the quarter of participation.

\_\_\_ Complete the attached application form with the faculty advisor and obtain his/her signature.

\_\_\_ Submit\*\* your completed application form and typewritten description of your research proposal to ERC Academic Advising by **Thursday of Week 2 of the quarter.**
