- Apply for my diploma at <u>http://degree.ucsd.edu</u> by the end of the last quarter I am taking classes.
- Make an appointment with ERC College Academic Advising if I have any questions or "just want to make sure" I'm all done.

Commencement—**OPTIONAL**

- □ Read all about commencement at https://commencement.ucsd.edu/ (check back periodically for updates)
- Choose to have my name added to the Commencement Program (booklet) at <u>http://degree.ucsd.edu</u> by May 1st even if DDA is not yet open for me to apply for my diploma.
- Rent my Cap and Gown at the UCSD bookstore in June (check with the UCSD bookstore for official dates). When I pay the ceremony and gown rental fees, I will get my ticket to the ceremony. This is my official "sign up" to walk.
- □ Optional: Attend the Commencement Ceremony. Students need to arrive one hour early.

How long will it take?

- Obegree Conferral: Generally, 90 days after the end of the quarter.*
- Diploma: Generally, 30-60 days after your degree has been conferred.

If you are applying for a SUMMER diploma your application will not be processed until after the end of all UCSD's summer session

*We recommend that your degree is conferred before ordering official transcripts for employment, grad school, etc. This time frame is not accurate for students filing retroactively or that have work-in-progress, "I" grades, or pending units transferred in from other institutions (including EAP, OAP, community college, UCDC, etc.)
