Discover how Hawaii's remote location, tropical climate, and diverse climactic zones create a unique setting unduplicated elsewhere. Hear the history and legends of the islands while engaging in service projects that benefit the environment and preservation of our unique culture.

Your participation in the program will provide you with an understanding of the Native Hawaiian culture whose ancestors sailed thousands of miles across the Pacific Ocean from Polynesia to settle in Hawaii around the 5th century AD. You will learn about America's annexation of the Hawaiian monarchy in 1898 and the colonization of natives pre- and post-annexation.

- Sunday, Depart to Honolulu, Hawaii
- Monday, Iolani Place/University of Hawaii (Hawaiian History and working in the lo'i (wetland taro fields)
- Tuesday, Traditional Hawaiian greeting followed by a guided hike in Waimea Valley along sacred trails past archeological sites and a range of habitat, completed with a service project in the valley's upland. Gain an appreciation of the Hawaiian culture through interactive arts and crafts. Learn how taro and other plants are grown and harvested in a completely organic way. Eat farm to table meal at a backyard pā'ina (dinner party).
- Wednesday, Service project in Waikalua Loko I'a (Hawaiian Fishpond)
- Thursday, Service project at Malama Manalua, Coastal Ecosystem Restoration
- Friday, Depart to San Diego, California
