### 2. Stuart Art Collection

The Stuart Collection at UC San Diego has commissioned more than 20 outdoor public sculptures by leading artists of our time. The permanent collection is distinguished from a traditional sculpture garden by its site-specific nature with many of the installations fused to university buildings and integrated into the landscape of the 1,200-acre university.

### 3. Geisel Library

Named after Audrey and Theodor Geisel (Dr. Seuss), the library houses UC San Diego's Dr. Seuss Collection which contains original drawings, sketches, proofs, notebooks, manuscript drafts, books, audio- and videotapes, photographs, and memorabilia.

### 4. Blue Line Trolley

### 6. AMC Movie Theater

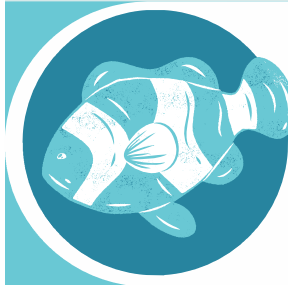
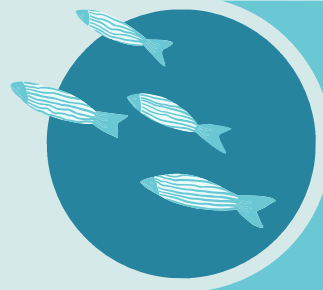

Enjoy the coastal views on the beach of La Jolla Shores and try the California-style dishes that their cafe has to offer.

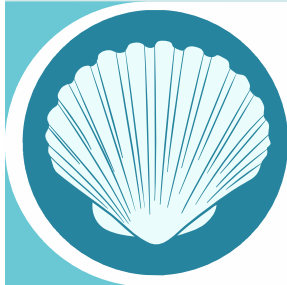

### 16. Balboa Park

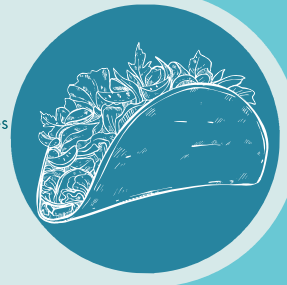

### 18. Little Italy

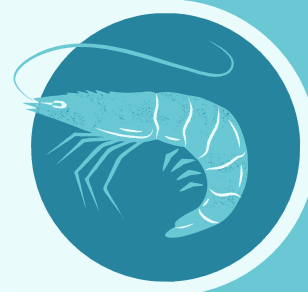
